Thorium Th 227 Anetumab

A radioimmunoconjugate consisting of anetumab, a human immunoglobulin G1 (IgG1) monoclonal antibody directed against the cell surface glycoprotein mesothelin, conjugated to an as of yet not disclosed chelating agent, and labeled with the alphaemitting radioisotope thorium Th 227, with potential antineoplastic activity. Upon administration the monoclonal antibody moiety of thorium Th 227 anetumab binds to the tumor-associated antigen (TAA) mesothelin, delivering a cytotoxic dose of alpha radiation to cells expressing mesothelin.

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
