# Attitude towards a behaviour

Behaviour Change Intervention Ontology (BCIO)

*Behaviour Change Intervention Ontology (BCIO)*

**Definition:** An attitude in which the entity that is the attitude object is a behaviour.

**Logical definition:** "affective attitude towards a behaviour" OR "evaluative belief about a behaviour"

**Curator note:** The class “attitude towards a behaviour” is logically defined as an “affective attitude towards a behaviour” or “evaluative belief about a behaviour”, as the term “attitude towards a behaviour” can be used to refer to either class.

*Definitions also often require elaboration to make it clear how they should be used and what they include. In those cases we include a comment.*

*Also, definitions sometimes require an explanation as to how they came about to help users understand how they relate to alternative definitions. In those cases we include a curator note.*
