- 1. Patients still need to be followed for longer periods of time, and the effectiveness of glucodiene in refractory bladder cancer has been established.
- 2. The authors say this may also be a potential treatment for triple-negative breast cancer. To avoid the increased likelihood of metastasis and recurrence, please give specific references and discuss in depth.
- 3. The case report needs more background and plain language to make it understandable to lay people.
