1. Patients still need to be followed for longer periods of time, and the effectiveness of glucodiene in refractory bladder cancer has been established.
2. The authors say this may also be a potential treatment for triple-negative breast cancer. To avoid the increased likelihood of metastasis and recurrence, please give specific references and discuss in depth.
3. The case report needs more background and plain language to make it understandable to lay people.
