My comments are as follows :

In the first page, funding and competing interests should be put at the end of the paper (before references).

The keywords should be put directly after the abstract (page 1).

Tables and figures should be reviewed for better alignment.

As you know, a family history of T2 DM is considered as one of the main risk factors for this chronic disease and should be included in this study.

In the last section (other references), the authors have put one reference without a number ! It should be included in the references with a number.

What do the superscripts following the reference numbers indicate ?

Finally, I suggest that the authors should add a paragraph to highlight the limitations of this study.

The manuscript should be reviewed regarding the language, grammar, and presentation in order to improve the quality of this article to be accepted for publication.
