My Comments

First and foremost, please let me congratulate you for your very nice study. My suggestions are as follows:

- 1. Abstract OK
- 2. Introduction In second paragraph, you explained various mental illness including psychosomatic disorders. But you frequently mentioned somatoform disorder that was not included in that paragraph. If psychosomatic disorder is equivalent to somatoform disorder, you better include it or mention it. Otherwise, readers will confuse.
- 3. Methods and Materials
- Under study setting, your description of adolescents' proportion was based on 2007 census. Now is 2023. Don't you
 have any latest information/census?
- Under Sampling technique and sampling procedure, you used "stratified multi-staged random sampling" and explained four stages. But I think only 3 stages, stage 2 and 3 were the same; isn't it? Stage 1 Random selection of schools;
 Stage 2 & 3 Three sections from grades 9-12 using stratified random sampling; Finally, students were selected using SRS! (Please check and rephrase!)
- 4. Results

All Tables - redraw yourself; don't copy and past directly from SPSS output!

Just above the Figure 1, at page 12, you used both CMD and CMI; should be used one and be consistent!

You already defined the presence of CMI if the score is 7 and above whereas in your graph 1, the categories are <5, 5-9, 10-14, >15 (should be \ge 15). Why don't you obliterate cut-off score 7. It makes the readers confused! Simply two groups It will make sense! <7; \ge 7 (or), <7, 7-??, ??-???! So also you failed to reveal the cut-off point for mild, moderate and severe categories!
