1. Check the botanical nomenclature at www.worldfloraonline.org because plant nomenclature contains errors.
2. Given that these plants have been extensively investigated, what was the reason for their selection?
3. The chemical characterisation of the obtained preparations is lacking.
- 4.. Because ethanol, even in low concentrations, has a considerable antibacterial impact, positive and negative controls are required to validate the results.

As a result, I've decided to resubmit after considerable revision.
