The paper covers an interesting and relevant topic but contains some flaws, particularly in the introduction and methodology sections. These sections are repetitive and unclear. The introduction should articulate the paper's objectives with greater clarity.

The literature review is too general and lacks the necessary context, and I think could be removed. To address this, some of the literature review section could be incorporated into the introduction by explaining why the topic is important and why the paper is necessary. In addition, the remaining discussion of the literature can be addressed in the discussion section. It is often assumed in this paper that accessing water and using facilities are the same thing, in the introduction this is explained but the literature review fails to make the distinction well.

The methodology section should provide a more detailed explanation of the search criteria employed. This section needs the most improvement. The results section provides useful insights and valuable information but could be strengthened by concise writing.
