1. Description of the Study Area	Page 6. "The predominant wave direction is from the W to NW, with a prevalence of NW (???). It is ONO) waves, accounting for 47%".
1. Evaluation of the Impact of Dredging on the Coast of Larache	Mapping of dredging areas and information on annual volumes of dredged sediment are essential. How these materials are reused.
1. Results	The authors should compare their results with those in the scientific literature at the national, regional, and international levels.
