Thanks to the author for this important piece of work. While there were some important inclusions done based on reviewer's recommendations, and it looks more improved, some headings/title could remain as it was like keeping the first section as 'introduction' rather than 'introduction to deafness'. The method section is more detailed now, but it looked it ended abruptly as it is sectioned now. I suggest either the author add more sections or just delete the subsections in methods section. There is one section called 'findings and conclusion', but after that section the author again introduced 'key findings' which is confusing. The author may go for a simple check of overall consistency once more throughout the manuscript as incorporation of ideas from different reviewers and putting them altogether sometimes create anomalies and may be difficult to incorporate successfully keeping the original tone. It is the author who needs to assure that the originality and the basic remains as it was while maintaining scientific rigor and quality at the same time.
