

Review of: "Resentment and Multiculturalism: Kymlicka's Canada, Bonilla Maldonado's Colombia and Modood's UK"

The article approximates several perspectives on multiculturalism and the issue of resentment among communities. The author uses several authors' perspectives from different contexts, such as Canada, Colombia, and the UK. While the author seems well versed in these authors' perspectives, there is no clarity about the reasons these perspectives should be read together or the purpose of doing so. On the flipside, the article lacks more context and appropriateness for employing concepts such as liberal/illiberal migratory/non-migratory multiculturalism, as the borrowed perspectives seem flattened out due to the lack of context for their application. Giving the reader more about why these debates are being held and favouring what (a literature review, a project, public policy) would make these perspectives work better in concert. More empirical case studies or application to these ideas would lead to a less hermetic piece.
