Title should change to "food safety of fresh commonly consumed vegetables: A review"

In the abstract author mention that "Vegetables are spoiled by a range of microorganisms including bacteria and fungi" and then the rest of the article talks about the incidence of pathogenic bacteria's that have been detected to contaminate fresh fruits and vegetables, which is the objective of the review. Then, authors should re-write the abstract.

What is the objective of the review??

Section 2.2. Is the principal section of the review; however, several aspects should be considered:

Is no relevant to mention the colony forming units of aerobic mesophilic bacteria since this is not a pathogenic bacteria and if mentioned is relevant to describe if the account complied with the provisions of the standard.

It is recommended to elaborate a Table with the describe in this section specifing the food, country of origin, pathogen detected, etc.

Section 2.3 should be focus on Prevalence of drug-resistant microorganisms in fresh vegetables.

Section 3, this section does not talk about risk assessment used in agriculture to avoid the contamination of vegetables then, it should be re-write.

The conclusion must be in accordance with the objective, however, this is difficult to evaluate because the review does not specify what the objective of the review is.
