

# Review of: "How many papers are published each week reporting on trials of interventions involving behavioural aspects of health?"

This is a small but interesting and important methodological study that may help estimate the number of studies addressing studies of health-related behaviour. I do not have serious comments except that the methodological approach should be described in more detail. The authors stated that 100 papers downloaded were manually inspected the titles of the papers to assess whether they were in scope (ie address health-related behavior). It is not clear how this manual inspection was performed, specifically whether this inspection was performed by two independent assessors.
