1.The review determines the effect of medical, surgical, and expectant-management procedures on women who have had spontaneous-miscarriages in their first-trimester. PROSPERO-International prospective register of systematic reviews—CRD42020154395.

These lines are repetition in the abstract.

2.The success rate in surgical intervention was higher when compared with medical intervention (OR: 16.12

This finding is missing in conclusion part of the article

3.Further studies are required to compare the medical with expectant care. Future trials should consider women's views and quality of life measures alongside the clinical outcome
