The general idea of the work is interesting. However, the Authors need to take into consideration the following points:

- 1. The grammatical structure and abbreviation are very poor. This makes the work difficult to understand.
- 2. The methodology should be presented in the past tense, not future, as it is assumed that the work was already carried out before reporting.
- 3. The abstract was poorly written and should be better presented to tie the work together.
- 4. The methodology is very sparse. It does not describe the extraction process, determination of oxidative stress, Morris Water Maze Test, as well as the rationale for these tests.
- 5. The units for the oxidative stress, MWM test, and weight were not indicated in the tables.
- 6. The micrographs were not properly presented, with the labels unclear and missing from the legend. Magnification and staining are absent, and the legends are not well presented.
- 7. Discussion is missing from the entire work, and an extensive discussion should be written with relevant references attached.
- 8. The same reference style should be applied, and recent details should be added.
