- While this is an interesting paper, I feel that the constructs need much more precision and development to make a serious contribution to the literature. There are key limitations, which unfortunately outweigh the contributions to the extant literature.
- After reading the introduction, I was unfortunately left with the feeling of "so what" as it did little to increase my interest
 in reading the remainder of the paper. Please focus the Intro much more on convincing readers that your study is
 needed and has the potential to add significant contributions.
- What are the theoretical and practical implications of your study and which limitations and possible future research emerge from it.
- The authors need to draw substantive conclusions from their results, and suggest, develop recommendations for further research.
