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This paper is well-intended, the arguments are clear, and the take is really important. What I like the most is the proposal. However, I think here the authors fall rather short. I would recommend strongly developing the proposals.

The suggestion that universities (in general) should do this or that remains a commonplace. What if they suggest creating networks of universities in order to foster repositories, publications, etc.? This issue cannot go without saying. A la lettre, what the authors suggest is the multiplication of entities - paraphrasing a well-known medieval idea.
