I would share two recommendations:

When the ejection fraction is described on MRI, I would mention which ventricle it comes from.

Also, I would add as additional clarification in your initial description that the abdominal situs does not necessarily have to match the thoracic situs. The description of dextrocardia (situs inversus totalis) may give the impression that dextrocardia is always accompanied by situs inversus of the chest and abdomen.
