- 1. Authors have failed to show the reasons for comparisons of two unlikely ago-ecological sites (Himalayan belt and the hot terrain).
- 2. The first paragraph of the Introduction section is not necessary to place in the manuscript. The authors would opt to write based on Indian conditions only.
- 3. Authors did not disclose why only two years of livestock population are compared on a national reference scale of India.
- 4. The livestock breeds adapted in both of the states have not been disclosed in the manuscript.
- 5. Referring to Table 2, the discussion perhaps does not explain why there is a slow adoption rate of exotic breeds of livestock.
- 6. Table 3 is missing??
- 7. Chapters for future strategies could be separated from conclusions, and the conclusion could be placed after the demanded strategy.
