Review of: "Strategic Synergies: The Untold Interactions Between Global Competitiveness and Logistics Performance in Sub-Saharan Africa"

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The study examines the relationships between the 12 pillars of the Global Competitiveness Index (GCI) and logistics performance in sub-Saharan Africa. It uses advanced statistical analysis techniques on data from 2007 to 2018.

1. The study is well-structured and organized.
2. The literature review needs to be developed; the author has to cite new studies, as the references in the study are just up to 2022.
3. The findings highlight the significant positive relationships between most of the 12 pillars of the Global Competitiveness Index (GCI). How do the authors recommend policymakers in sub-Saharan Africa prioritize and balance investments across these interconnected pillars to optimize logistics performance in the region?
4. The study does not explore potential moderating or mediating factors that could influence the GCI-logistics performance nexus. What are some key contextual factors, such as institutional quality, infrastructure development, or human capital, that could provide additional insights if incorporated into future research on this topic?
