I was not sure how the conceptualization of the complex adaptive systems approach was being employed. There was much discussion of entrepreneurial ecosystems, but I think there could have been more discussion about how complex adaptive systems could be applied here.

I think the emphasis is on rural entrepreneurs, and I am not sure that rural settings lead to much complexity.

I agree that all successful businesses that have survived for an extended period must adapt to environmental changes. I suggest that existing enterprises must adapt to the creative destruction of entrepreneurs to survive, possibly more than vice versa.
