- 2. Any quantitative or statistical data to support the relevance of conducting such a study should have been provided.
- 3. Separate sections for Introduction and Review of Literature should have been provided.
- 4. Proper basis of formulating the hypotheses should have been provided in the Review of Literature.
- 5. The standardised scales used in the study for each construct should be mentioned with proper references and citations.
- 6. Methodology needs thorough revision: It should answer the questions like-
- Why Thailand especially Bangkok is taken for the study?
- why only 400 respondents taken as sample?
- who qualifies to be your respondent?
- why stratified random sampling if the population is infinite? what were the basis for formulating the strata?
- what's the time frame for this study?
- 7. There should've been proper sections dedicated for theoretical and practical implications of the study at the end.
- 8. Who are going to benefit from the study and how?

I guess adding these points in the research would render such a study excellence. I hope the researchers will take these reviews in their stride.
