The research is good and describes a phenomenon that already exists in West Java based on the available information from several sources, but in my view, the cultivation of konjac should be carried out with certain systems with other types of crops under intercropping for two reasons:

Firstly) to maintain the productivity of other crops in this region

Secondly) to increase the productivity of konjac when it is grown in the shade (under another crop in the same piece of land or in alternating with another crop at certain intervals)
