The paper presents a good survey of competence frameworks.

To clarify the reading, it would be nice, before presenting the first framework (the European one), to describe shortly the different frameworks to give structure to the paper and make it easy to understand their applicability. Besides, the titles and subtitles could be made different to be able to distinguish the overall structure of the paper.

Even though it is an opinion paper, the contents do not seem to justify its title: It is not easy to understand why the role of competence frameworks is essential. There is a lack of examples showing who is using the different frameworks and their experiences. For instance, table 1 looks very interesting, but it would be more helpful with an explanation of its use.
