Differences in the formation process of each nation (including a minimum of one country per continent, and each political regime), establishment time of current political status, historical contextualisation of the political regime evolution, and other social-historical-variables should be taken into account to further analyses. The authors should have previously checked data normality and homoscedasticity for determining the choice of Pearson correlation, for example.
