

Review of: "Academic Integrity in Poland: A Culturally Sensitive Code of Ethics Proposal"

When defining the research problem, it would be useful to mention the results of research on the problem in Poland in order to justify the problem. For example, it is important to refer to research that will make an argument such as "In Poland, the acceptance of dishonest exam writing is much higher than in other countries." visible to the reader. In addition, the relationship established between artificial intelligence and the scientific works of academics under the title "Seeing the problem" is not sufficiently placed in the context of the research problem, this issue is not addressed in the rest of the text and the discussion is not expanded.

The results of the studies mentioned under the title "A. Scale of the problem - researches" should be shared in a way to show the level of the current problem in Poland compared to other countries. In addition, if the educational systems of the countries where the tendency to cheat is low are explained, it would contribute to understanding the problem not as a behavioral problem at the individual level, but as a systemic problem at the structural level.

The research problem could be examined by conducting a field research. A research with the participation of students and teachers could help to understand the causes of cheating behavior in Poland and the answers received could also contribute to the solution of the problem. Thus, it may be possible to justify why the ethical codes mentioned in the title "Suggestion of a culturally sensitive code of ethics" are important to solve the problem in the context of Poland. Otherwise, it is not clear why these codes were chosen as suggestions but not others. Additionally, the references of the text do not allow for an analysis that would lead to such an inference.

If field research is not planned, giving more space to research conducted in countries experiencing the problem and focusing on examples of countries that have managed to overcome similar problems would make the conclusions and recommendations of the article more consistent.
