The authors have adopted a satisfactory methodology to answer the research questions, since these were based on themes relating to collective guilt, search for meaning and well-being. It is understood that the participants in the research were capable of writing their own narrative in their native language, this being seen as a positive approach to ethnography, which could however have also taken the form of transcribed oral narratives. The discussion refers to results that can also be found in post-colonial narratives, and is therefore relatable to experiences of other nations around the globe.
