On one hand, I found the "Public Speaking Training Plan based on the Toastmasters International Competent Communication Manual" very interesting, innovative (but also assembling classical theories too) and described in a very clear way.

On the other hand, this expected quality, cannot be an objective of the study, due to the lack of experimental methodology (as when the authors say: "This approach effectively reduces communication apprehension and gives students the skills and confidence to deliver impressive oral presentations"). If the aims of this article are descriptive and theoretical only, this should be addressed. If - on the contrary - the paper means to expose about the validity of the plan, methodology and results should be addressed.

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
