Review of: "Enhancing Annotated Bibliography Generation with LLM Ensembles"

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The author does a great job in positioning his work on the topic of using LLMs to annotate bibliography. Nevertheless, the methodology lacks reproducibility and does not highlight bias issues. Regarding reproducibility, there is no code available to reproduce his framework, and there is no information about the dataset. Knowing the domain of the dataset will establish the limitation of LLMs' domain expertise since how accurate LLMs are in the assigned tasks depends on their training. The bias issues have to be tackled as a limitation and proposed as future work, such as fine-tuning certain LLMs on all or some of the most relevant tasks of the proposed framework.
