The methodology is clear, and so is the analysis and conclusions. However, it is important to state the study objectives. This would help the reviewer to provide a more focused judgement.

For data analysis, I would recommend Table 3 to have chi-square, then Table 4 to show crude and adjusted odds ratios for the variables found significant in Table 3.

Please limit the discussion section to the findings of the study. For instance, ectopic pregnancies do not appear in the study findings, yet we have them in the discussion section. The discussion should basically state what the implication of your pertinent findings is and compare this with what other studies have found out.

Please include study limitations and recommendations, including the implications of these findings for public health practice.
