Thank you for this article which effectively summarizes relevant aspects of *Pacem in Terris* written by Pope John XXIII. In order to improve, at least in my opinion, the present paper I suggest to keep in consideration three points. As mentioned, the article projects the relevance and the main features of *Pacem in Terris*. Yet, it says too little of the topic, which appears in the title making the reader interested in hearing more about the relevance of a World Government in today's world. Though a quick and short reference is made about Pope Francis' position in this relevant matter, it appears, at least from my perspective, too little in order to meet with the expectation the title may generate in those who will read it. Pope Francis has tackled this topic in several occasions and probably these could be mentioned. I refer in a special manner to his address to the United Nations, during his trip to United States of America. Another most recent contribution is letter he has written the Bishop of Hiroshima (Japan) just yesterday on the occasion of the meeting of G7 in the Japanese city. In case the author may find it unsuitable to deepen this aspect, I suggest a change in the title to make it more consistent with the present text. A second suggestion is in regard to the editing of the text. Instead of listing down with dots aspects to be underlined (it appears on two occasions - on page 3 and 4 -) I would suggest that the author may keep a flowing text. Finally, I suggest a careful revision and editing examination in order to eliminate minor spelling or typing mistakes. I hope these suggestions may help to improve this interesting study.
