Overall, this mini-review presents a structure and language that are easy to follow. Yet, I suggest a revision of the English used. The references should also be revised as they are not equally formatted and sometimes, they are not appropriate for the subjects mentioned.

I would like to see some points further discussed, as this mini-review lacks details. Namely:

- 1. Regarding the frequency of sinus infections, some numbers would be useful to understand the true impact of the disease.
- 2. For diagnosis, it is mentioned the utilization of X-rays and CT scans in some instances, but those instances are not mentioned.
- 3. In terms of antibiotic resistance, I do not see the necessity of an initial definition and the reference used to support how antibiotic resistance impacts sinus infections is very general and does not mention sinus infections.

I believe that after a careful revision and inclusion of the details mentioned above this mini-review can be improved and become a useful piece of literature for sinus infections. At this point, I do not think it should be published.
