

Review of: "[Mini-review] The Global Impact and Management of Foodborne RNA Viruses"

The review briefly summarizes the main information regarding the impact and the management of foodborne RNA viruses. The review can be useful for a first approach to the topic, and the text is well structured. Besides, some data requires to be double-checked (the number of cases each year is underestimated), and some aspects are repeated in different parts of the text (the impact of handling).

The mini-review shows comprehension of the main issues regarding the topic, and it exposes the information in a way understandable for non-experts, but it lacks a critical reading of the information acquired; for example, the decision to consider the hepatitis E virus as ignorable seems arbitrary and not supported by scientific literature.
