- 2. The structure of the introduction of the article is unreasonable, for example, the tenth paragraph and the last paragraph are similar content and do not need to be separated.
- 3. The article lacks theoretical analysis, and the selection of influencing factors needs to be supported by theory.
- 4. The empirical analysis only verifies the correlation and does not carry out causal identification, which is a very big flaw.
- 5. The article only analyzes the influencing factors of credit availability, but does not carry out mechanism tests, and the analysis is not in-depth enough.
