Comments:

- A large part of the article focuses on the software and how to implement it.
- The scientific name of the species is mentioned in italics.
- There are many repetitions of sentences in the text; after the explanation in another section, there is no need to refer
 again.

Some abbreviations were not found in the description table.

- Referencing in some sentences must be corrected because the author has tried to make the sentence passive using this method. (Example: "Phuntsho & Tshering, 2014" instead of "by Phuntsho & Tshering, (2014)").
- In the introduction of the study area, additional explanations are not necessary, and a brief explanation is sufficient.
- Since they have chosen a large area, it has caused the accuracy of the work to decrease. It is suggested to choose
 areas that are geographically, ecologically, and ecologically important to be able to identify more precisely the desired
 habitats.
- In the discussion section, other studies have not been used to compare with the results of this research, and this section has not been expanded.

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
