The author discusses various models of teacher professional development under the Indian higher education system and puts forward relevant views on the significance of teacher professional development. There are still some suggestions which need to be incorporated:

- 1. In the introduction, the author should explain why he has made a comparative analysis of the various models of teacher professional development under the Indian higher education system. As to why the connotation and type of the professional development model of Indian higher education teachers are not given the corresponding background explanation and discussion. The research perspective is relatively backward, and the innovation highlights are not obvious.
- 2. The author only lists the research achievements of many scholars in the introduction, which is more like a literature review.
- 3. The literature review is too concise, the methods used are not explained enough, the research questions and corresponding analyses are not clear enough, and the results and discussions are not well expressed.So, the recommendation is for major revision.
