I appreciate the considerable effort invested in this work, addressing a pivotal aspect of the theoretical consideration of the reasons causing superpowers (in this case, the United States) to fail in wars against small countries, but unfortunately, I cannot support the article for publication in its current form.

While the concepts presented in this paper are well developed, there are several concerns that need attention before the manuscript can be considered for publication:

- While the article touches upon important aspects of the American mission in Afghanistan, I feel that the analysis could be further developed and clarified.
- Some areas where improvement is needed include providing more specific examples and evidence to support the arguments presented, ensuring coherence and consistency in the presentation of ideas, and addressing any gaps in the analysis.

I believe that addressing these concerns will significantly enhance the manuscript's clarity, making a stronger case for its acceptance in **Qeios**. I encourage the writer to carefully consider and incorporate these suggestions into a revised version of the manuscript.
