- The manuscript would benefit from the inclusion of recent studies in the field to strengthen and support the presented work. It is essential to integrate current literature to provide a comprehensive and up-to-date understanding of the subject.
- To enhance the credibility and relevance of the study, it is advisable to incorporate new references that align with and support the arguments made in the paper. This can contribute to a more robust theoretical framework.
- The conclusions drawn from the study could be further strengthened with additional explanations. Providing more detailed insights into how the findings address research questions and objectives would enhance the overall impact of the study.
- The practical implications of the study, often referred to as the implications or applications section, are not clearly articulated. It is important to discuss how the study's findings can be applied in real-world scenarios or future research directions.
- The structure of the manuscript appears somewhat disorganized and resembles more of an essay than a scholarly article. Reorganizing the content to align with the standard structure of a scientific paper would improve clarity and readability.
