The author has a great idea, as is analyzing the paradigm shift in the delivery of education.

However, I think some changes could be made, which would help to improve the document:

- 1. rethink the structure of the document. It would be good to clarify the objectives and methodology. It is not clear what the author is looking for, nor what method has been used.
- 2. make explicit why Zambia, throughout the text there is no reference to the country, to the context of education there, and it would be interesting to introduce it, or change the title.
- 3. it would also be advisable to introduce some critical reference about this paradigm shift, such as follows:
