Dear Authors, thank you for this intersting manuscript. The paper is full of relevant informations about sustainable agriculture in Turkiye, but in my opinion they should be differently organised in order to become interesting for publication in a scientific environment. I would suggest to follow one of the following routes.

1) to realise a discussion paper in which you critically review the measures implemented (or not implemented) in the country to face the crucial issues of climate change and sustainable farming. The aim of this paper would be to contribute to the knowledge of the agricultural and environmental policy in Turkiye and to critically assess its most likely effects locally and in the country.

2) to realise a research paper in which you focus on a specific relevant research question on the matter and analyse, either qualitatively or quantitatively on the base of a relevant methodology, the possible answer(s) to that specific research question. For example, one relevant question could be referred to water management in agriculture in the country, or to the implementation of agro-environmental measures, and so on.

In any case, a good introduction highlighting the objectives of the paper and some short conclusions aimed to recap the main findings will help.

At the moment, the paper is mostly a list of bullet points detailing in quite a random order all the measures activated in the country, and it figures more as an institutional report (although a bit chaotic) than a scientific contibution.

Please report and number properly figures and tables which are directly connected to what you are aimeing to present in your paper.
