I appreciate the author and the guide for implementing the novel techniques for the detection and treatment of hyperglycemia-related breast cancer. I will recommend it for publication after the following minor points have been adequately answered.

Comment-1. The author should make the abstract more attractive by presenting the results properly.

Comment-2. It would be better if the author could provide previous research work on the Warburg Effect and compare it to these results.

Comment-3. Whether there are any side effects of Glucosodiene monitored?
