2. The design of the research method is not clearly mentioned. Please explain the type of study and the study method in detail. It seems that this study is a descriptive correlational study, the data was collected cross-sectionally, part of the data was collected by questionnaire and part by interview. The claim of a qualitative study should be deleted.
3. The method of sampling should be explained in detail. Is the sampling random or available?
4. Data collection tools and how to validate them should be mentioned.
5. The results should be very summarized, and the ethics of the research should be mentioned.
