The article employs a nice methodology and demonstrates contextual innovation. It provides an

excellent example of conducting a street vendor survey in a non-vending zone. However, there are

certain limitations that could be addressed. For instance, the geographical scope is limited, and the

perspectives of street vendors are not represented. Additionally, the study could benefit from

exploring potential solutions, such as designated vending spaces, to better address the conflict

between law and implications. Additionally, some grammatical errors are still there, like the use of

"stationer" instead of "stationary"; correct them as well.
