

Review of: "Health Outcome and Economic Growth: The Case of Malaria in Nigeria"

Manuscripts related to Health Outcome and Economic Growth: The Case of Malaria in Nigeria are very important to inform academic and public audiences, but these manuscripts need language improvement and correction of terms and phrases that are difficult for ordinary people to understand.

The abstract should clarify, "The findings show that current health expenditure has an inverse relationship with economic growth in Nigeria; how much is the best relationship based on this statement?" The authors also need to determine what prevents this from happening.

In the introduction, previous research related to the two variables used in Nigeria is not shown, the purpose of the study is not expressed, and what benefits are derived from this modeling? Malaria prevalence data over several periods should be presented to support the statement in the introduction.

The modeling is still using the main data; presenting the results should include your findings and processed data. It is difficult to understand. Although the data presented is good, the correlation between health outcomes and economic growth is not very clear. It is important to illustrate the results well and correctly.

Limitations of the study should be disclosed at the end because there are several points that become questions and have not been able to be answered from this research.

Recommendation: Major Revision
