- The manuscript is not well structured: one should clearly see (1) introduction; (2) materials and methods; (3) results and/or discussions; (4) conclusion and/or recommendations; (5) references
- The manuscript contains too many overstatements that are not backed by evidence. Some statements are simply incorrect, such as the statement on the world's current population of 9.8 billion.
- World as a case study seems too broad for me. World soil is very heterogeneous. If one wants to study soil at a planetwide scale, he/she might need to divide it into more or less homogeneous components for deeper analysis.
- The language is poorly written and needs to be really improved to allow readers to grasp the information the author is trying to communicate.
- I would like to share my commented file with the author for more detailed considerations.
