I deeply recommend the article for publication.

The article deals with many subjects in a deep, convincing, and extended way. It is both profound in the argumentation and accessible also for readers who do not have experiences in philosophical texts: therefore, the article can address a different audience. It develops the concept of time in different applications and use of the concept.

A noteworthy richness of examples is present in the text: this renders the text better connected to the experience of the reader, enlarging at the same time the reader's capability to meditate on the concept of time.

The article is well organised: the structure of the paragraphs is well thought out. Footnotes enrich the text in a considerable way. The bibliography analysed is relevant and extended.

Since I am not an English native speaker, I am not able to evaluate the English of the text in a complete way. The level of English seems nonetheless to me to be very good.
