

## Review of: "A Study to Assess the Effect of Pelvic Floor Muscle Strengthening Exercises on Urinary Incontinence in Patients with Cervical Cancer Undergoing Radiation Therapy at a Tertiary Cancer Centre"

Cervical cancer and its treatment are written at length in the article's introduction. Since the aim was to determine the effect of pelvic floor muscle exercises on urinary incontinence in those receiving cervical cancer treatment, it seems to have gone beyond the scope. Writing the cervical cancer rates in one sentence as continuing cancer treatment after urinary incontinence caused the flow to be disrupted. It would be appropriate to review the introduction section again. Research hypotheses need to be written in the materials and methods. Adding a control group to the study would have made the study more powerful. However, publishing the article after editing it with these suggestions will contribute to the literature.

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
