The article addresses an interesting topic for current cities.

The title summarizes the content of the article but should avoid acronyms.

The article is correctly written, reviews relevant literature and presents its results adequately.

The use of quantitative and qualitative methodologies is a success since it allows the analyzes to be complemented.

However, it is important to justify why these neighborhoods have been chosen and characterize them socially and urbanistically. The number of interviews/surveys seems small and it is not determined how the people who responded were chosen.

Along with that, it would be interesting if the results and conclusions specified the emerging factors that emerged from the qualitative analysis. It would also be important to deepen the correlation between the factors that had greater weight at a quantitative level with those rescued at a qualitative level in each neighborhood.

This relational analysis could offer more interesting findings over the categories analyzed in the article.
