The order and development of the sections is well thought out and effectively contributes to the clarity and coherence of the document.

Regarding Table 1, I have a few suggestions for improving the clarity and presentation of the data. On Table 1, the scientific names related to etiology, many names are written without the space between the binomial names. For example, "Madurellamycetomatis". I would recommend reviewing the table to ensure consistency and clarity in the presentation of data points.

Furthermore, I would like to comment on the bibliography used in the manuscript. Overall, the selection of references is appropriate and contributes to the depth and relevance of the study. While it is noted that approximately 9% of the bibliography dates back to the last 10 years, this is not uncommon for review articles. Considering the nature of your work as a review, this distribution is understandable and does not detract from the quality of the manuscript.

In conclusion, I want to commend you on the thoroughness and quality of your revision. The manuscript is well-prepared and effectively addresses the research objectives outlined. I believe that implementing the suggested revisions, particularly regarding Table 1, will further strengthen the manuscript and improve its overall impact.
