Review of: "Review, Evolution, and Theoretical Implications of the Utility Concept"

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This article offers a detailed survey on the evolution of the concept of utility in Economics. The article is well-written, well-structured, rigorous, and informative. My only advice to the authors is to take a final look at the paper in order to improve some formatting issues. The ones I believe need correction are the following: (i) most of the paragraphs in the paper are too long, which makes them hard to read; please present shorter paragraphs; (ii) review the presentation of references in the text; some are confusing (e.g., the first reference in the introduction); (iii) correct typos (e.g., at the end of page 8, 'the the'; on page 2, the acronym PU appears before the corresponding definition).
